Bancroft is currently conducting this \$36 million modernization project. Howard High School is one of the oldest High Schools in the State of Delaware with a campus that is comprised of two buildings. The first was constructed in 1927 and the second building was completed and opened in 1972. The project encompasses major-phased renovations and includes the following elements:

- Buildings' envelopes
- Buildings' systems including mechanical, electrical, HVAC, fire protection, sprinkler system and overall life safety code upgrades
- Security upgrades
- Classroom and office renovations
- Common spaces including the main entryway to the school and all hallways
- Two kitchens and cafeteria
- Gymnasium
