**William B. Keene Elementary School**

A 64,600 square foot structure, William B. Keene Elementary School, houses approximately 31 classrooms, group learning areas, an administrative office, a library, a cafeteria/kitchen, and media, art and music rooms. The school features state-of-the-art synchronized communication and clock systems, wiring for computers and a closed circuit television system with satellite hook-up capabilities.

Construction was suspended for nearly a year due to on-site archaeological finds including Native American artifacts and Colonial pottery. In spite of the delay, Bancroft successfully maintained the entire Project Team as well as all subcontractors and completed the project on budget and within the adjusted time frame.
